MINUTES CENTREVILLE COUNCIL

REGULAR MEETING

The City Council of the City of Centreville met in a regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday evening, Apr 7, 2026, in the Centreville City Hall at 5:00 P.M., regular place and time for holding said meeting.

Mayor Barry Cooner called meeting to order at 5:00 pm, followed by invocation and Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call

Members: Mayor Barry Cooner, Don Mack, Sr., Diane Epperson, Linda Lawrence, Aaron Hood, Akeyla Holifield.

Mayor Cooner declared a quorum present and meeting was open for business.

Linda Lawrence made the motion to approve the minutes from the last council meeting and was seconded by Dianne Epperson. All council members approved. Motion carried.

Don Mack made a motion to approve financial report. Aaron Hood seconded, all approved. Motion carried.

Dane McKinney gave a Fire Department report.

Police Chief Rodney Smith gave a Police Department report.

Don Mack made a motion to accept the highest bids on the surplus Police vehicles. Aaron Hood seconded the motion, all approved. Motion carried.

Akeyla Holifield made a motion to approve participation in St of AL Back to School Sales Tax Holiday July 17-19, 2026. Don Mack seconded, all approved. Motion carried.

Don Mack made a motion for those council members needing training hours to attend the League of Municipalities Annual Convention April 28-May 1, 2026. Aaron Hood seconded, all approved. Motion carried. Council will travel to Montgomery each day and not stay overnight.

Attending the conference will be Linda Lawrence, Dianne Epperson, Akeyla Holifield, Aaron Hood, Barry Cooner.

Don Mack made a motion to set Zoning Board Meeting dates as 3rd Monday each month at 5PM, to begin on April 20, 2026. Dianne Epperson seconded, all approved. Motion carried.

Katie Cheslock gave an update on Centreville Main Street, announcing that they will be hosting a Senior Night Out with the high school Main Street group and selling Boston Butts to fund. BCHS has discontinued the Senior Picnic and this will take place of that. Aaron Hood made a motion to approve the Event Permit for the event, allowing street closure around the Court Square for the evening. Dianne Epperson seconded, all approved. Motion carried.

Mayor Cooner presented a second quote for roof repair/replacement on the apartment/old fire station. The council asked for 1 more quote. Mayor Cooner reported that the insurance company was contacted about a claim. The deductible for that building is \$25K so a claim was not filed.



Akeyla Holifield made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Dianne Epperson seconded, all approved. Motion carried.






