RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT

I hereby certify that I am the duly elected and qualified Mayor of the City of Centreville, a municipal corporation. I am also a custodian and keeper of the records of the City of Centreville. The following is a true and correct copy of a resolution adopted at a meeting of the city council held at 1270 Walnut Street, Centreville, Alabama, on December 16, 2025. The meeting at which the following resolution was adopted, was held in accordance with the laws of the State of Alabama and the resolution is now in full force.

Whereas, the sale, distribution and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the city limits of the municipality of Centreville is governed by Ordinance 7-20-2010; and

Whereas, Section 16(1) of the aforementioned ordinance allows the city council to grant special event permits which would allow an organization to hold an event or gathering within the municipality and allow the patrons to consume alcoholic beverages provided by the sponsoring organization; and

Whereas, Centreville Main Street, Inc. has petitioned the City Council for the City of Centreville for a special event permit which allows the distribution and consumption of alcoholic beverages at the event along an area of Court Square; and

Whereas, the area for the event is described as the sidewalk on the east side of Court Square commencing at the office of Michael L. Murphy extending to the sidewalk on the southern border of Walnut Street, and the sidewalk on the West side of Court Square commencing at the Centreville Press building and extending to the sidewalk on the southern border of Walnut Street and all area within the previously described boundaries; and

Whereas, the event is a fund raising event for Centreville Main Street, Inc. and is intended to promote the revitalization of the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is resolved by the City Council of Centreville, Alabama as follows:

1. The City Council of the City of Centreville grants Centreville Main Street, Inc. a special event permit pursuant to Section 16 (1) of Ordinance 7-20-2010.
2. The permit commences at 10:00 a.m. and expires at 11:59 p.m. on December 27, 2025.
3. Centreville Main Street, Inc. is allowed to provide at no cost alcoholic beverages to ticketed patrons. The patrons may consume the alcoholic beverages in an open temporary entertainment district described as follows:

An area in and around the Court Square in uptown Centreville which includes the sidewalk north of Walnut Street commencing at Alfa and continuing eastward to the corner of Court Square and all area northward to S. W. Davidson Drive including the parking lot of the Courthouse Annex; Walnut Street commencing at Alfa and continuing eastward to

Kennedy Street and including that area southward to 1st Street; the roads designated as Court Square East and West, including the Court House and all grounds comprising the front, sides and rear of the Court House lot lying between S. W. Davidson Drive, Court Square East and West and Walnut Street. The East Sidewalk along Court Square as well as any property owned by Centreville Baptist Church is specifically excluded from the Entertainment District.

4. The alcoholic beverages provided are limited to beer and wine. Compliance with all provisions of Ordinance 7-20-2010 not affected by this special permit as well as the laws of the State of Alabama regarding the consumption and possession of alcoholic beverages is required.
5. All alcoholic beverages served by Centreville Main Street, Inc. must be placed in a non-breakable container for consumption by patrons and will be served to patrons inside the old Peoples Bank Building located at the corner of Walnut Street and Court Square.


